FORM INSTRUCTIONS							

TIMES: Local time and must match the official radio log.

STATUS: R = Released, L = Lost, B = Boated

SPECIES: Black Marlin, Blue Marlin, Striped Marlin, Sailfish, Spearfish

REPORTING PROCEDURES

- 1. Use a separate Scorecard for each day; record the date at the top. Official time is GPS, recorded to the full minute.
- 2. When you hook a billfish, call Radio Control and report the Team Name, Angler, Species, & Grid. As soon as you release, boat or lose the billfish, call again to confirm and verify. Billfish being fought at lines out must be reported to Radio Control prior to lines out.
- 3. If you caught a billfish you must turn in the Scorecard on the same day. You may email a picture of your scorecard to release@bisbees.com. If you did not catch a billfish, you do not need to turn in a Scorecard.
- 4. The Team Captain must print their name and sign indicating they agree to the information as recorded. Local contact information must be completed.

Release Division Digital Media Requirements

Teams entered in the Billfish Release Division must verify their catch by taking Digital Photos or Video. Digital media must be continuous, show the billfish next to the boat, and clearly make the species identifiable. Teams are expected to provide their own digital camera and connection medium. The date and time on the camera MUST be set correctly to local time. Refer to Tournament Rules for more information.
